For successful food plots, most seed varieties require good soil and plenty of water, which is a tall order in some parts of the country. Whitetail Select's Severe Premium Whitetail Forage Seed is the first mix designed specifically for sandy soil and dry conditions. WIND CHECK

Detecting wind direction for proper preseason stand placement (and later while you're hunting) is never as easy as it looks, especially when breezes are light and where they tend to swirl (see "Current Affairs," p. W14). The Pro's Wind Gauge by Sportsman's Edge works on any tricky wind; its proprietary suspending particles seem to defy gravity as they reveal subtle air currents and thermals. ANYWHERE MOUNTS

Can't find a straight tree to mount your trail camera? Can't find any tree? Trail-Pod's Screw-in Tree Mount and Tri-Pod may be the solution. The former is basically a screw-in tree step attached to a ball head and universal mounting plate. It lets you mount any camera on any crooked branch or trunk and easily point the lens in any direction. The latter allows you to put your camera in a treeless area (a locking system is sold separately). \$60-\$90; 866-634-3196; trail-pod.com

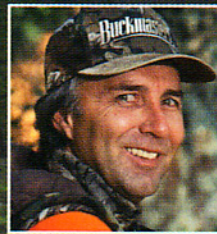
ALL WRAPPED UP
